18. After forty years in the wilderness, the Israelites came to the plains of Moab. Moses died there, and his general, \_\_\_\_\_, led them into Canaan (also known as “the Promised Land”).

22. Then the Kingdom is Divided into the Northern Kingdom (called Israel and governed by King Jeroboam) and the Southern Kingdom (called Judah and ruled by King Rehoboam – son of King Solomon). The Temple is located in the Southern Kingdom and King Jeroboam tells his subjects not to worship at the Temple but to worship idols instead of the one true God. (*no question just a statement*)

23. The worst king of Israel is King Ahab who marries Jezebel, a Baal worshipper. The prophet \_\_\_\_\_ confronted the prophets of Baal and had to run for his life. He later anointed the prophet Elisha to take over for him and was taken up to heaven in a whirlwind in a flaming chariot with flaming horses.

24. Those who speak on behalf of God, defend the truth and work for justice are called \_\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ prophesies about Jesus Christ in Isaiah 7:14, addressing the "house of David," meaning the family and descendants of King David, and speaks of a virgin being pregnant with a child, and giving birth to the child. He also says that the child would be referred to as "Immanuel," which means, "God is with us."

25. A prophet chosen by God at an early age, \_\_\_\_\_ brings a message of judgment and a message of hope. Announcing God's judgment against Judah's sins, but promises a future restoration.

26. **The Maccabean Revolt (167 B.C. – 142 B.C.): Judas Maccabeus takes charge of the revolt and cleanses the Temple. The Temple menorah is lit and 1 day's oil lasts 8 days. This yearly feast is \_\_\_\_\_ or the “Feast of Lights.”**

27. The Holy Family is Jesus, \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

28. Jesus is born in \_\_\_\_\_. His family takes him to Egypt to hide from King Herod the Great. When King Herod is dead, they return to live in Nazareth. Jesus learns the trade of \_\_\_\_\_.

29. Jesus' cousin, called \_\_\_\_\_ is the prophet who baptizes Jesus in the Jordan River.

30. Jesus fulfills prophecies of the Old Testament. He begins his ministry approximately at age 30 in 30 A.D. and performs miracles, teaches, and calls disciples. His mission is to die for us so that we may be saved. His ministry lasts three years and in 33 A.D. we see the fulfillment of his mission. His suffering, death, resurrection and ascension into heaven is known as the \_\_\_\_\_ mystery. We celebrate these important events during the Easter Triduum, also called the Christian Passover since Christ passes over from death into new life for us all.

31. We read in Mark 16:19 and Luke 24:51 that on the fortieth day after Easter Sunday, Christ \_\_\_\_\_ into heaven.

32. 50 days after Jesus Resurrection, the Holy Spirit is sent down to Jesus' disciples who are praying with Mary in the upper room. This is known as the Feast of \_\_\_\_\_. This is also the birth of the Early Church. We can read about this in the Acts of the Apostles.

33. The New Testament is composed of 27 books which include the Gospels, Acts of the Apostles, 21 Epistles (Letters written to instruct and encourage different Christian communities), and the last book of the Bible, the Book of Revelation. **(no question just a statement)**
