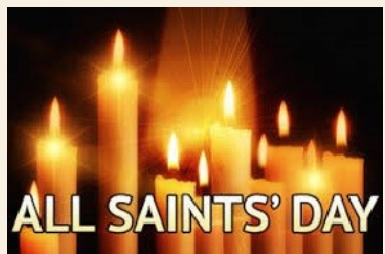

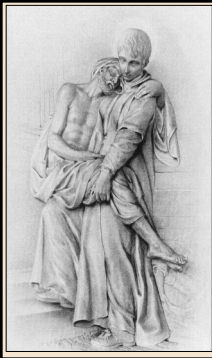
A Close Reading of the Second Encyclical of Pope Francis

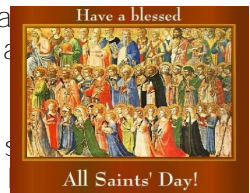

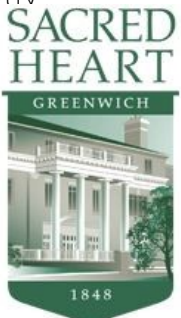

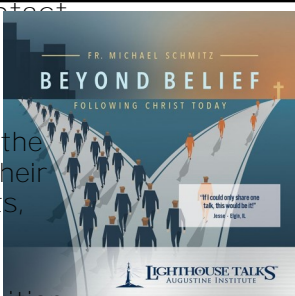
