#### MARRIAGE:

Call the John Palma at 203-652-1140 at least nine months prior to the wedding date.

If someone is ill at home or in the hospital, please call the Parish Office at 203-966-0020 to arrange for Communion and administration of the Sacrament of the Sick. 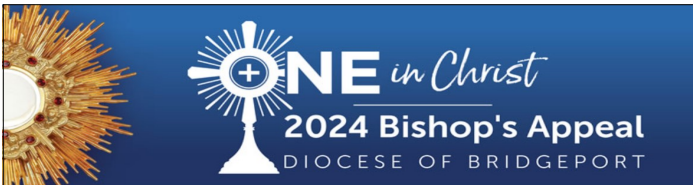

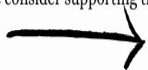


