RENOVATION AND BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE

- The new air conditioning conduits for the church will be installed this week in the chapel floor. The chapel will be unavailable for part of the week because of that work.
- The concrete pour for the first floor of the school building had to be postponed because of rain, so we are hopeful about next week.
- The feasibility survey for the preschool had a good response of nearly 200 participants. Thanks to all who went online to complete the survey! The consultants will present the findings and make recommendations at the end of June. Shortly after we will announce the enrollment plan for the school.
- Parishioner Holly Lemoine will speak at the Masses this weekend about the campaign from the parishioner perspective.

Our pledge total is \$20.5million which is \$5.5million away from our goal. Thanks to all donors! Our participation rate is about 50% of active parish families. WE NEED YOU to help complete this project! Your sacrificial gift will enable us to provide everything planned for our bright future.




