So many things to say this week, so little space in my bulletin column to say them, but here's a try:

Our **young adult ministry** had their first gala last Saturday. It was a spectacular event that featured more than 100 guests, a beautiful tribute to Chris Otis, great food, a DJ that had everyone on the dance floor, fantastic silent auction items from generous donors, and an overall feeling of celebration of God blessing our inspiring young adults.

We have been asked to help our brothers and sisters who rely on the **New Covenant Center** for food by donating to the March 1 food drive in our parking lot. Recent funding cuts have limited the regular grocery delivery to New Covenant, and we are being asked to fill the empty shelves. Thanks for helping on Saturday, March 1.

We will have the **"in-pew" drive for the Annual Bishop's Appeal** this weekend. The "ABA" provides the funds to support some of our diocesan ministries: education, retired priests, religious education, the many social services provided by Catholic Charities, and more. 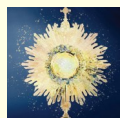

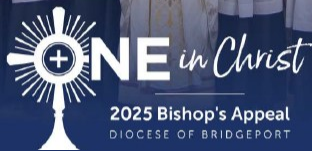
