### Breakfast with Jesus

There are four stories in this Sunday's post-Resurrection Gospel: the appearance of Jesus to the disciples, the large catch of fish, the meal, and the commission of Peter. The sight of the Risen Lord to the weary and defeated fishermen-disciples should have had all the emotion of a reunion with loved ones, but only John ("the disciple whom Jesus loved") recognized Jesus. Far from disappointed, Jesus does what Jesus does - he gives abundantly, and the disciples haul in "a net filled with 153 large fish." The nighttime of emptiness becomes the dawn of fulfillment because of Jesus.

We encounter Jesus in his providence and love for us when we receive blessings, consolation, peace, and "our daily bread." Imagine meeting the Lord and hearing him say to you, "Come, have breakfast." What would you say? Shouldn't it be the other way around? Shouldn't I be offering a meal to Jesus? But that's not the way it works. Jesus is so generous, so loving, and so hopeful about us, that someone like Peter -- who denied Jesus three times -- can become "the rock" after he thrice-proclaims his love for Jesus.

We are all invited to allow the Lord to feed us and send us on mission. Why not invite someone who has been away from prayer, church, and a friendship with Christ to have breakfast with you. (Nutritionists say it's "the most important meal of the day.") Tell him or her about your experience of Jesus feeding you: in word, in Sacrament, in the gift of blessed ones in your life. Tell of the times you experienced Jesus saying, "I love you." Then invite that person to go where Jesus is sending him or her, and offer to go on the journey, accompanying with prayerful support. It might be the best meal you've ever had, and you both might wind up in Heaven where breakfast with Jesus never ends!

### The Gift of Trees

I was saddened that we had to take down two trees on the church property this past week. Our gardeners, arborists, and I had been watching these trees for several years as they started to show signs of decay. Last year we had a few incidents including a large branch breaking off and landing on a parishioner's car. Thankfully no one was injured. Our insurance inspector noted the potential for more breaking branches and further signs of sickness. To avoid future accidents, and after consulting with the town, we made the decision to take down the trees. Happily we are planning to add a great number of trees to the church property as part of our project. As I've mentioned at Mass, last fall I traveled with our landscape architect from Peter Gisolfi Associates to the tree farm in New York to see the trees that will adorn our parish grounds. Robert, the amazing tree farmer, and Ronen, our landscape architect, got along swimmingly as they talked back and forth using the Latin names for the trees that are headed to New Canaan this September. The Elms are the same Elms that populate Elm Street in New Canaan, the many varieties of Maples include fiery red ones that will stand at the entrance of the new chapel, and the many other species are hearty and beautiful and will be planted on the South Avenue side of the Education and Faith Center, on the great lawn between the Church and the Education and Faith Center, and even in the parking lot. Working with the town's planning and zoning committee, we have chosen trees that are native, beautiful, and strong. I'll provide more details about the various species; but in the meantime, we are preparing to celebrate God's gift of nature on the tree-planting days ahead!
