



St. Aloysius parishioners may now hear worship services inside the church amplified by easy-to-use technology called **ListenWIFI**. **ListenWIFI** is the most advanced wireless audio streaming product on the market. If you would like to boost your hearing of a service using your own iOS or Android smartphone to headphones, earbuds or digital hearing aids. Use the following instructions to connect:

1. Your first time connecting - **download the ListenWIFI app** on your phone from the Apple App or Google Play Store. You can do this as home before coming to church. 
2. Once in the church, **connect to the church wifi** network by scanning the QR code posted on the walls. (Note – your phone will automatically connect to the church wifi on future visits) 
3. Once connected to the wif network, open the ListenWIFI app on your phone.
4. Connect your headphones or earbuds to your phone and press any available audio channel to begin listening.


