### Words from Monsignor Rob Kinnally

#### Saint Carlo Acutis!

On Sunday, September 7, Pope Leo XIV will canonize Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. These two entered the Kingdom of Heaven as youth, and both are known for their love of Christ, the Church, and their extraordinary and inspiring zeal. I thought it would be helpful to tell you something about these two new saints, and so this week we begin with St. Carlo for whom our new chapel will be named.

Carlo Acutis was born May 3, 1991, in London. Shortly after his birth, his family moved to Milan. From a very early age, Carlo had a special love for God. His mother admitted that she was not a churchgoer, but her son managed to bring her and other relatives to Mass every day and convince many more to receive Holy Communion daily. Carlo had a gift for empathy and was known for defending children at school who were bullied, especially those with physical challenges. He loved soccer and video games, exhibiting unusual discipline by limiting his video game time to one hour per week. He had an affinity for computer programming and taught himself computer coding and animation.

Saint Carlo was devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary (of whom he said, "She is the only woman in my life") and he loved to pray the rosary, stating that the Rosary is "the most important appointment of the day." Carlo loved the Eucharist, was particularly fascinated by Eucharistic miracles, and created a website to catalog and share information about the miracles. He demonstrated a great desire to bring people back to the Church and Holy Communion encouraging visitors to his website with these words: "the more often we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of heaven." Connecting reception of the Eucharist to living a Christlike life, Saint Carlo remarked: "Virtue is acquired primarily through an intense sacramental life, and the Eucharist is undoubtedly the culmination of charity. Through this sacrament the Lord makes us be complete persons, created in his image."

At age 15, Carlo was diagnosed with an untreatable leukemia. He offered his suffering for others dealing with illness: "I offer all the suffering I will have to suffer for the Lord, for the Pope, and the Church." Saint Carlo died from his illness on October 12, 2006. At his request he was laid to rest in Assisi because of his love for St. Francis. The Archbishop of Assisi said of this new saint: "Carlo is a boy of our time. A boy of the internet age, and a model of holiness of the digital age."

My favorite Saint Carlo quote reminds us that we are created in the image of God, and each of us has been given unique gifts; therefore we must live our life cooperating with God's individual plan for us: "All people are born as originals but many die as photocopies."

Be sure to get your Saint Carlo prayer card when you come to Mass this weekend.

## 20th Anniversary of the St Aloysius Pilgrim Virgin Invite Our Blessed Mother into YOUR Home

The "Pilgrim Virgin" is an international tradition that has commemorated Our Lady of Fatima for more than half a century. Since most people are unable to make a pilgrimage to Fatima, Our Lady, with characteristic humility and love, overcame this difficulty by reversing the process. She became the Pilgrim in 1947.



In 2005, Fr. Les and members of Our Lady's Guild went to Fatima and brought home our very own statue of Our Lady in order to start this tradition at St. Aloysius. Fr. Les blessed the statue on September 8th, the birthday of Our Blessed Mother. For the last twenty years, our Parishioners have been invited to have the statue in their homes with the suggestion that the Rosary must be prayed before the statue each day. Some people pray before the statue with their family. Others invite neighbors in to pray the Rosary with them. Many request the statue for special occasions.

#### ARE YOU OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW INTERESTED IN THE CATHOLIC FAITH?

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, OCIA, is an awakening to Christ and seeking out the Catholic Church that comes about in a variety of ways. The first step for some is a sense that “something is missing”, that there is more to life than what they now have. For many others, the journey begins because of a relationship with a Catholic – a close friend or spouse. Some were baptized Catholic but did not receive any other sacraments. Still, others are drawn by seeing the example of a Catholic life well lived.

The OCIA process is a series of carefully planned stages, marked by liturgical rites, in which those who are interested in becoming full Catholics join us in a continuing and deepening conversion into faith and discipleship. It takes the spiritual needs of each person into account. At the Easter Vigil Mass, candidates will receive those sacraments of initiation that they need – Baptism, the Eucharist, and Confirmation.

In mid-September, our parish will begin weekly OCIA sessions in an open and welcoming environment. These gatherings are open to people who are unbaptized as well as those who are baptized Christians from Protestant or Evangelical backgrounds.




