#### BAPTISM



Music Notes for The Baptism of the Lord  
Dr. John Michniewicz

- The readings feature the first "Servant Song" from Isaiah, Psalm 29 highlighting God's thundering voice over the waters; the Gospel account of Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist, and the Theophany (the manifestation of God).
- The Entrance Hymn, "To Jordan Jesus Humbly Came," connects Christ's baptism to our own, using the tune WINCHESTER NEW, connecting it to the Advent hymn using the same melody "On Jordan's Bank" with its depiction of John the Baptist announcing Christ's coming.
- Music for the 11:30 Mass includes the Christmas Carol "Tomorrow Shall Be My Dancing Day" at the Presentation, and the contemporary, meditative Communion piece "My Son, the Beloved" by David Blackwell, highlighting Christ's baptism.
- The Final Hymn, "Songs of Thankfulness and Praise," summarizes the entire Epiphany season, celebrating Christ's manifestation through the star, his baptism, and his ministry, and calling for grace to imitate him.
