Music Notes for the First Sunday of Lent
Dr. John Michniewicz



The liturgical readings for the First Sunday of Lent focus on the themes of sin (Genesis), repentance (Psalm 51), and Christ's obedience in triumphing over temptation (Romans 5 and the Gospel of Matthew).

The Entrance Hymn, "Forty Days and Forty Nights," reflects on Jesus' fast and temptations in the wilderness, calling believers to share in the Lenten spiritual discipline of fasting, prayer, and resisting temptation.

The Presentation Hymn, "Jesus Tempted in the Desert," poetically recounts Christ's three temptations from the Gospel, highlighting his human vulnerability and his reliance on God's Word.

The 11:30 Mass features two anthems based on Psalm 51: Robert J. Powell's "Restore My Soul" at the Presentation, and Matthew Culloton's "Create In Me A Clean Heart" as the Communion meditation, both serving as prayers for spiritual renewal and cleansing.

The final hymn, "Lord, Who Throughout These Forty Days," summarizes Lenten themes by recalling Christ's example of fasting and overcoming temptation. It encourages believers to use the Lenten season to "die to self" and prepare for Easter's resurrection.


