Music Notes for 7th Sunday of Easter Dr. John Michniewicz



This Sunday, May 17th, 2026, is the Seventh Sunday of Easter, the final Sunday of the Easter season before Pentecost. The readings reflect the liturgical period after the Ascension of the Lord, before the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The readings center on three great themes: the community gathered in prayer (Acts 1:12-14), confidence in God's protective care (Psalm 27), and Jesus' great priestly prayer for glorification, protection, and unity (John 17:1-11). Sunday's hymns and anthems reflect these themes throughout.

Sunday's opening hymn is *Praise to the Lord, the Almighty*, whose second verse: "shelters thee under his wings, yea, so gently sustaineth," speaks directly to Jesus' prayer for God's protection. The presentation hymn, *God We Praise You!*, is based on the ancient hymn known as the Te Deum. Its text acclaims Christ's glory and evokes the community united in praise.

At the **11:30 Mass**, the choir will sing the anthem *With a Voice of Singing*, which serves as a celebratory selection reflecting the Alleluias of Easter and a joyful expression of God's deliverance, mirroring Psalm 27. Sunday's communion hymn *There Is One Lord* (Berthier) draws directly from Ephesians 4, reflecting Jesus' prayer "that they may be one." The choir's communion meditation, *Most Glorious Lord of Life* (Chilcott), setting Edmund Spenser's Easter sonnet of 1595, traces the entire arc of the Gospel, from glorification, through protection, to the closing prayer for unity and love.

Immaculate Mary is **Sunday's recessional hymn**, a beloved hymn honoring Mary during the month of May. The hymn serves as a reminder that Mary herself is named in the First Reading as one of those gathered in the upper room, united in prayer as the Church awaited the coming of the Spirit.


