Living Life in the Spirit

The feast of Pentecost brings us to that moment when the Holy Spirit descended on those gathered in the upper room. The apostles and Mary, the mother of Jesus, are transformed by the wind of fire of the Holy Spirit. The fear that brought them to the locked room turns to a Spirit-filled relief and peace because they know that Jesus will always be with them.

The Holy Spirit breaks into our lives just at the right time: when we are lonely, lost, fearful, despairing, and uncertain. The Spirit prompts us to respond with confidence in God's providence to the challenges that come our way. The Spirit nudges us when we can't decide where we are supposed to be. The Spirit sets our hearts on fire when we are getting lukewarm in our life with God and one another. The Spirit is everywhere when we think we are nowhere. What a gift!

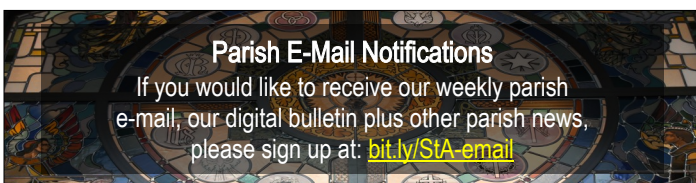
And speaking of gifts, the Holy Spirit imparts wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. Music Notes for Pentecost Sunday Dr. John Michniewicz



Sunday's Entrance Hymn: *Come, Holy Ghost* (No. 544), a translation of the 9th-century *Veni Creator Spiritus*, opens the Mass, invoking the Holy Spirit through titles drawn directly from Scripture and Augustinian theology.

Fr. James Chepponis's setting of Psalm 104 *Lord, Send Out Your Spirit, and Renew the Face of the Earth* leads into the Sequence Hymn, *Veni Sancte Spiritus*, known as the "Golden Sequence" as a masterpiece of medieval sacred poetry attributed to the English Archbishop Stephen Langton, moving through petition, praise, and consolation. **The Presentation hymn** is *O Spirit All-Embracing*, set to Gustav Holst's famous THAXTED melody, at the 11:30 Mass in a festive arrangement by Fr. Chepponis for brass, percussion, and organ, with text by Sr. Delores Dufner, OSB.

The Hymn during Communion is *Laus Tibi Sancte Spiritus* (No. 539) featuring a contemporary text by Mary Louise Bringle, set to a 13th-century Easter melody. This Pentecost hymn offers a vivid portrait of the Holy Spirit inspired by the mystical writings of Hildegard of Bingen; the choir also sings Craig Courtney's *One Faith, One Hope, One Lord*, referencing Sunday's Second Reading from 1 Corinthians 12.

Sunday's closing Hymn features **Mine Eyes Have Seen the Glory of the Coming of the Lord**. **At the 11:30 AM Mass**, the choir will sing Peter Wilhousky's celebrated choral arrangement. This hymn's imagery of God's truth marching on and Pentecost's transforming Spirit connects it to the commemoration of Memorial Day.


