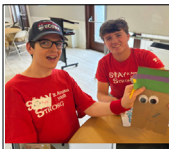

ARE YOU OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW INTERESTED IN THE CATHOLIC FAITH?



The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, OCIA, is an awakening to Christ and a seeking out of the Catholic Church that occurs in a variety of ways. The first step for some is a sense that "something is missing", that there is more to life than what they now have. For many others, the journey begins because of a relationship with a Catholic – a close friend or spouse. Some were baptized Catholic but did not receive any other sacraments. Still, others are drawn by seeing the example of a Catholic life well lived.

The OCIA process is a series of carefully planned stages, marked by liturgical rites, in which those who are interested in becoming full Catholics join us in a continuing and deepening conversion into faith and discipleship. It takes each person's spiritual needs into account. At the Easter Vigil Mass, candidates will receive those sacraments of initiation that they need – Baptism, the Eucharist, and Confirmation.

In mid-September, our parish will begin weekly OCIA sessions in an open and welcoming environment. These gatherings are open to unbaptized people as well as baptized Christians from Protestant or Evangelical backgrounds.

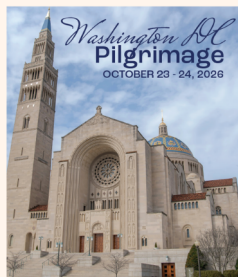

Music Notes for 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Dr. John Michniewicz

The readings for August 30 center on examples of discipleship: Jeremiah's word burning like fire despite mockery, Psalm 63 speaks of thirsting for God, Romans 12 gives a call to be a living sacrifice, and Matthew 16 gives Jesus' call to "take up his cross and follow me." **"Sunday's Opening Hymn: Lift High the Cross (No. 885):** George Kitchin wrote the text in 1887; Michael Newbolt revised it in 1916 to the version sung today, set to Sydney Nicholson's tune CRUCIFER ("cross-bearer").

Preparation of the Gifts: As a Fire Is Meant for Burning (No. 734): Ruth Duck wrote the text in 1982 after a mission trip to Turkey; its fire imagery echoes Jeremiah, set to the early American shape-note tune BEACH SPRING.

Communion Hymn: Unless a Grain of Wheat (No. 759): Bernadette Farrell wrote both text and music in 1983, based on John 12:24, paralleling Matthew 16's teaching that life is found by losing it.

Communion Meditation: I Surrender (Matt Crocker): written for Hillsong's 2012 album Cornerstone, its language of surrender and desperation for God mirrors Jeremiah and Psalm 63 and Jesus' call to take up his cross.

Final Hymn: Lord, Whose Love in Humble Service (No. 780): Albert Bayly wrote the text in 1961, set to the Dutch folk tune IN BABILONE, emphasizing discipleship's call toward acts of service to all.
