Praying Together as a Town

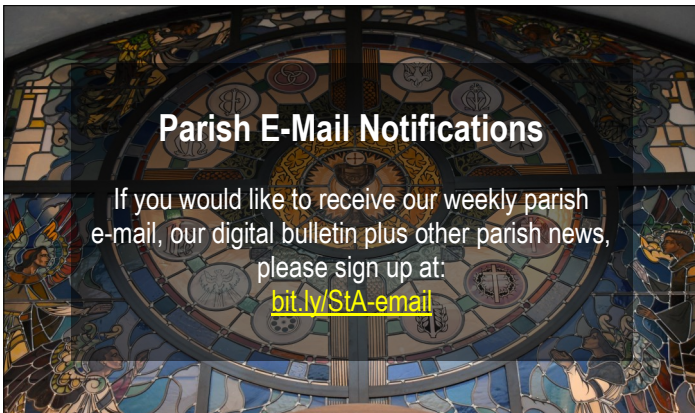

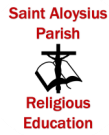
