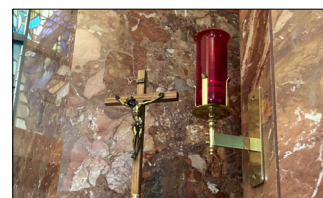

Resolutions

So here we are at that annual crossroads where we reflect on the year gone by and resolve to do something better, nicer, greater (you name it) in the year ahead. I've come to believe that the best way to formulate a list of new year's resolutions is to begin with prayer and dedicate the list-making – and even the year – to Mary, the Mother of God. Think about it, who better than Mary? She probably never made big plans, but she submitted completely to God's plan for her. She likely never created a list of things she would work on the following year, because she dedicated her life to obedience of the list of God's commandments in Torah. She may never have looked back on the year gone by with an ounce of regret because she proclaimed "the Almighty has done great things for me!" And she was never at a loss for what to do in a day, a week, or a year because her life was spent in quiet resolution to give her Son to the world and remind us to "do whatever he tells you."

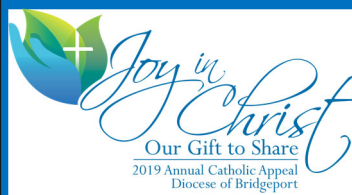
