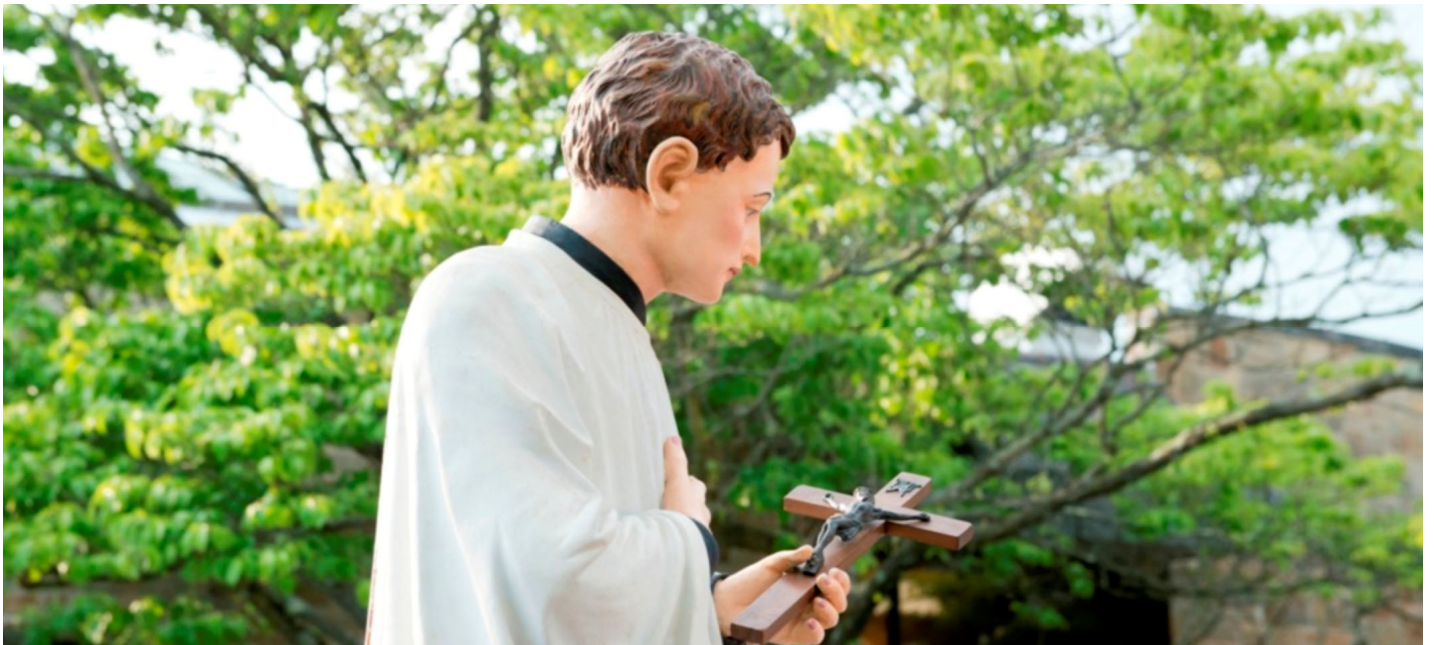

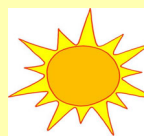
Veteran's Brick Orders
