

Our teens spent a morning running the food pantry at the Thomas Merton Center in Bridgeport.






Fan the Fire Youth Rally

The apparition of July 13, 1917

This apparition was perhaps the most startling, stunning and stark of the monthly apparitions. It was on this day that our Blessed Mother showed the children three distinct visions and made requests and prophecies concerning the visions. She instructed the children to not reveal what they were shown until directed to do so at the proper time. These three visions and prophecies became known as the 3 Secrets of Fatima.
