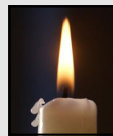

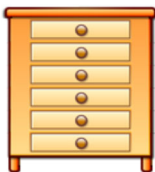


Mother Teresa's Closet will re-open after Monday, September 3rd! At that time we will be accepting gently used clothing from infant through adult. We are in particular need of infant and

toddler items. We thank all the wonderful members of our parish for their most generous donations and continued support of our ministry throughout the year.

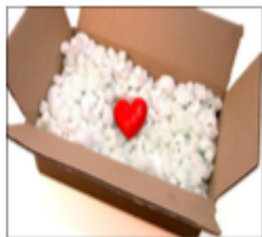
