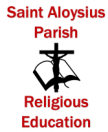

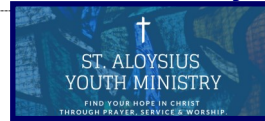
MARRIAGE:

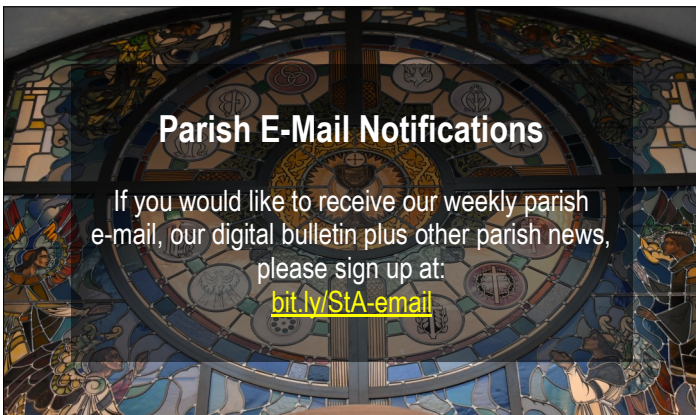
