

#### Father Bernard A. Keefe



Rev. Bernard Augustine Keefe, age 89, passed away peacefully while praying, on Tuesday, July 26, 2022.

Father Bernie was born on April 21, 1933. He served in the United States Navy from 1951-1955. He received his priestly formation at Christ the King Seminary in Olean, New York and was ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Albany on December 21, 1963.

Following his ordination, he began his priestly ministry at Immaculate Conception Church in Scotia, New York. In subsequent years, he served at Saint Mary Church in Glens Falls, New York and Saint Mary Church in Hudson, New York.

In 1976, Father Bernie came to the Diocese of Bridgeport; his first assignment was at Saint Charles Borromeo Church in Bridgeport. He was transferred to St. Peter Church in Danbury in 1981 and then five years later to St. Maurice Church in the Glenbrook section of Stamford. While serving at Saint Maurice, Father Bernie was incardinated into the Diocese of Bridgeport on April 25, 1988.

In 2004, we were blessed to have Father Bernie move to Saint Aloysius Church where he served until his retirement in 2008. Many parishioners will remember Fr. Bernie's avid devotion to the NY Yankees and the UCONN women's college basketball team. His gift of humor and kind and gentle nature brought great peace to all he served.

Bishop Frank J. Caggiano will celebrate Father Bernie's Funeral Mass on Saturday, August 20, 2022 at 9:30 am at St. Aloysius Church. The homilist will be Monsignor William Scheyd.

Not Catholic? Were you baptized Catholic and have not received all the sacraments?


