### Words from Father Rob Kinnally

#### Understanding the Mass – The Liturgy of the Word, Part 1

Once the introductory rites are concluded with the collect (opening prayer), we move to the proclamation of the Word. On Sundays, the pattern is this: a reading from the Hebrew Scripture (Old Testament), followed by a Psalm, a reading from the Epistles (letters of Paul, Peter, James, Hebrews, and others), and then the Gospel. In Easter time, the first reading is taken from the Acts of the Apostles.

In the Liturgy of the Word, the Church feeds the people of God from the table of his Word (cf. *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, no. 51). The Scriptures are the word of God, written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. It is here that God speaks to the assembly, and as the story of salvation unfolds in our hearing, we are reminded that God is leading us along the path to being saved. How often have you heard a reading and said to yourself: "I feel as if that message is being given directly to me at this moment for my benefit!" Well, that's the word of God, which is living and active, speaking to our hearts.

The Responsorial Psalm is preferably sung (because the psalms were always sung in the temple – Jesus sang the psalms when He worshipped!). The psalm helps us to meditate on the word of God.

The high point of the Liturgy of the Word is the reading of the Gospel. Because the Gospels tell of the life, ministry, and preaching of Christ, it receives several special signs of honor and reverence. The gathered assembly stands to hear the Gospel and it is introduced by an acclamation of praise. Apart from Lent, that acclamation is "Alleluia," derived from a Hebrew phrase meaning "Praise the Lord!" A deacon (or, if no deacon is present, a priest) reads the Gospel. After the minister announces the Gospel ("...according to Luke"), the tradition is that we all sign ourselves with the sign of the cross on our forehead, lips, and heart, saying "May the words of the Holy Gospel be in my mind, on my lips, and in my heart." At the end of the gospel, the priest or deacon kisses the Book of the Gospels and says quietly: "May the words of the Gospel wipe away our sins." Don't ever underestimate the power of the words of Jesus; remember His words when He forgave sins, drove out demons, cured the sick, and raised the dead!

Let us pray: Lord, draw us closer to you through your word proclaimed at Mass. Open our minds and hearts to your message, and may we always proclaim your Gospel on our lips and in our actions. Amen.
