A Few Things...

I will resume my series on The Mass next week, but today I want to share a few thoughts about some happenings this weekend.

Our teen candidates and an amazing, hard-working team will gather for **Emmaus 81**. This three day retreat directed to high school sophomores, juniors, and seniors, helps the candidates to know Christ better and draw closer to Him. The Emmaus Retreat has been an ongoing ministry in this parish since the early 1980's! The team is composed of teens, young adults, and adults of Saint Aloysius who take the time to help the candidates to walk with Christ, just like those who encountered Jesus on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24). Please pray for the teens and adults who will step away from their usual weekend routine to meet Christ in prayer, Sacraments, and the gift of one another.

On Saturday, I will break away from the Emmaus weekend for a little while to celebrate with **Melanie and Scott Barnard** as they receive the **Saint Augustine Medal for Service to the Church** from Bishop Caggiano.
