Words from Monsignor Rob Kinnally

We Have Some Growing Up to Do

How often has a child been challenged by a parent with the words "You have some growing up to do!" The words usually follow a bad decision on the part of the child who didn't "follow the rules," and are meant to encourage continued work toward the goal of maturity. We "grown-up" Catholics still have work to do as we strive to follow the Law of the Lord. As suggested in today's Scripture readings, the Commandments are a gift to us and provide the guard rails we need to live the life of a true disciple. In the first reading, we are reminded that God's law is lifegiving and a means of our salvation:

If you choose, you can keep the commandments they will save you. If you trust in God, you too shall live.

These words are an echo of Deuteronomy 30:19-20:

I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Choose life, that you and your descendants may live, by loving the LORD, your God, heeding his voice, and holding fast to him.


Jesus comes to fulfill the Law and show us by his example that to be truly "grown up" followers of Jesus, we need to write that Law on our hearts, know the Author, and live by the Law. And furthermore, there is no compromising allowed ("Let your yes mean yes"), and no swearing either! Saint Paul in today's second reading sums it up nicely when he said that the Commandments became "a wisdom to those who are mature."

Let our prayer be this: Give me discernment, Lord, that I may observe your law and keep it with all my heart. (cf Psalm 119).

It is a joy to grow up with you in faith.






