

Campus Parking Improvements Underway

As part of the ongoing site improvements, we're excited to share a more comprehensive update on how parking and vehicle access across the campus will be enhanced in the coming months. A key feature of the updated plan includes a new drop-off area serving the Education Center, located near the Maple Street side of the property. This area has been thoughtfully designed to allow for safe and efficient car queuing and student drop-offs, supporting our growing children's and youth ministries. Additionally, five electric vehicle (EV) charging stations will be installed to support sustainable transportation and convenience for EV drivers in our congregation and community. In front of the church, the current drop-off loop will be extended, and three new accessible (handicap) parking spaces will be added improving access for those with mobility challenges. Lastly, the existing




parking lot near the Cherry Street entrance will receive new landscaped islands. These features not only improve traffic flow and aesthetics but are also designed to reduce the heat island effect, contributing to a greener and more environmentally responsible campus.


