Words from Monsignor Rob Kinnally

Saying "Yes"

Once again, the scripture speaks of Christ as the "light of the nations." As we plod our way through the dark of winter, we are brightened by the healing ministry of Jesus who in this Sunday's Gospel invites us to repent to live out our own call to be His followers. The etymology of "repent" reveals that the term means not merely having a sense of regret for what we have done (or not done); but because "penitence" shares a root, it means acting in charity having reflected on regrets. Also associated with repentance is metanoia, a Greek word that means to turn things around, to have a change of heart. To put it in a Christian context, it means directing our hearts to the task of doing God's will. This challenge to repent that comes from Jesus is not a Lenten activity alone because the Kingdom of God is here and now AND yet-to-come. So, we must be ready, we must respond with a hearty and definitive "yes" like those first disciples whom Jesus called. They put down their nets and followed Jesus through every adventure; and in every step of the journey, they learned more about Jesus and about themselves. They looked back on their own lives and looked forward to living more like Jesus. They turned their attention to His words and actions and were thus able to make their hearts more like the heart of Jesus.

We are all called by God to something with and for God. There is joy in looking back on our lives, taking stock of how God has blessed and challenged us along the way, and then responding without worry to today's call. The best part of saying "yes" is knowing that God goes with us. So, to what is God calling you today? What do you need to respond generously? How will you make the Kingdom of God known this week?

Enjoy the journey!

Music Notes for the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time **Dr. John Michniewicz**

- The readings for the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A) focus
- us on the start of Jesus' public ministry as the fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy of a "great light" shining on the "land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali."
- The Gospel (Matthew 4:12-23) highlights Jesus' move to Capernaum and his call of the first disciples (Simon Peter, Andrew, James, and John) to become "fishers of Men," emphasizing his message of repentance and the coming of the kingdom of God.
- The music selections reinforce the themes of light, salvation, and discipleship, with the Entrance Hymn You Call To Us, Lord Jesus focusing on Christ's call and the Presentation Hymn I Want to Walk As A Child of the Light connecting Jesus to Isaiah's prophecy.
- The 11:30 Mass includes Gabriel Faure's Cantique de Jean Racine (a prayer for divine light) and Karen Marroli's contemporary Light Of the World (which directly echoes the call to follow Jesus) during the Presentation and Communion, respectively.
- The final hymn, The Kingdom of God, set to LAUDATE DOMINUM, ties the readings together, emphasizing that God's kingdom is characterized by justice, joy, mercy, and is a call to action for the faithful.

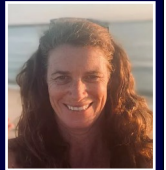
