Words from Monsignor Rob Kinnally

Beatitudes and Sundry Items

The Gospel this Sunday is part of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. The "Beatitudes" are a reminder that we can count on God to provide for us as we live out our discipleship. In our mourning, humility, working for justice, and peacemaking we are "blessed" because we are proclaiming the Kingdom of God. We are comforted, shown mercy, and will see God. The Beatitudes challenge us to Gospel living and demonstrate that doing the will of God (which may involve suffering and sacrifice) is a life-giving joy that leads to the Kingdom of Heaven.

We had a **snowy Sunday** last weekend that had quite an effect on our ability to worship in church in large numbers. Saturday evening's Mass was like Christmas Eve, but Sunday saw dwindling attendance as the storm intensified. Lots of you watched and prayed with us via the livestream. I'm so grateful to Gregg Strba and his hard-working team behind the plows and shovels. They did a great job keeping the parking lot and walkways as clear as possible. I'm hopeful we don't have another storm like that on a Sunday! We got some great photos of snow angels and the stories of sledding and skiing balanced out our grown-up complaints about shoveling and cleaning off our cars. It always helps to look out on the freshly fallen snow and see it as a beautiful blanket given as a gift to us from God's creative energy.

The **interior work on our Education and Faith Center** is well underway. At this point almost all of the wall boards are up and the next team will arrive *en masse* this week. I'll have a more detailed update including photos in the weeks ahead.

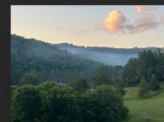

Music Notes for the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time Dr. John Michniewicz

The music selections for the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A) reflect Jesus' teachings in the Beatitudes from the Gospel of Matthew and the emphasis on humility, justice, and God's favor for the poor and lowly.

The Entrance Hymn, "Praise My Soul The King of Heaven," is a hymn praising God for God's eternal goodness and care for the humble, echoing the themes in the First Reading (Zephaniah) and the Second Reading (1 Corinthians).

Psalm 146, "Blessed are the poor in spirit: the kingdom of heaven is theirs!" and the Presentation Hymn, "I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say," reflect Jesus' teachings in the Beatitudes.

The 11:30 Mass features the choir's presentation of: "The Beatitudes" by James and Marilyn Biery, a poetic setting of the Gospel text full of vibrant imagery, and the Communion Meditation, "Let Your Faith Be Stronger Than Your Fear" by Tom Trenney, an moving anthem and meditation on the hope and courage that come from the message of the Beatitudes.

The Final Hymn, "O God, Beyond All Praising," uses the majestic THAXTED hymn tune and a modern text that focuses on God's blessings, showing gratitude and encouraging a steadfast faith throughout all seasons of life.

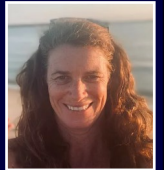
