In addition to his parish responsibilities, Deacon Michael will serve as Vice Chancellor of the Diocese of Bridgeport. Music Notes for The Feast of St. Aloysius
Dr. John Michniewicz

This Sunday's Mass celebrates the Feast of Saint Aloysius Gonzaga, patron saint of the parish and of Catholic youth, with an extended musical prelude at 11:30 AM featuring the Choir and Brass Ensemble before Bishop Frank Caggiano celebrates the Mass at Sunday's special 12:00 Noon time.

The readings for the feast present a single vision: love of God is expressed through faithfulness to God's commandments, and that faithfulness is not a burden but true freedom. Saint Aloysius lived that vision completely, renouncing his noble inheritance and giving his life in service to plague victims in Rome.

The prelude features works for Choir, soloists and Brass Ensemble, including the beloved gospel anthem *Order My Steps*, Philip Stopford's *The Spirit of the Lord*, and Philip Wilby's *If Ye Love Me*, each reflecting the feast's themes of love, service, and commitment to God's commandments.

Newly ordained Deacon Michael Crane serves at Mass for the first time and delivers his first homily. His request of *Ave Maria* by Franz Schubert places his new ministry under Mary's care and intercession.

The Presentation Hymn is the *Hymn to Saint Aloysius*, composed especially for the parish, followed at Communion by *The Eucharist My Highway Home*, a new work honoring Saint Carlo Acutis, the first millennial saint, whose chapel will grace our campus.

The Feast concludes with the celebratory hymn: *God of Our Fathers*, a fitting tribute on Father's Day, June 21, 2026.

Convalidation

Catholics who were married outside the Catholic Church and wish to receive the Sacrament of Matrimony may do so through convalidation. As the Body of Christ, the Church desires to accompany and care for her



members, inviting baptized Catholics to enter into marriage within the Church and receive the grace Christ offers through this sacrament. If you are Catholic and not currently in a sacramental marriage, entering into the Sacrament of Matrimony is often a simple process, provided you are free to marry in the Church. Convalidation is sometimes described as having a marriage "blessed" by the Church, but it is actually the exchange of vows and the celebration of the sacrament itself.

If either spouse has been previously married, proof of an annulment (or completed marriage nullity process) must be provided before proceeding.

There is no set preparation period for couples who are already civilly married.

Requirements:

- At least one spouse must be a baptized, practicing Catholic, registered in the parish, and free to marry in the Church. Any previous marriages of either spouse (Catholic or non-Catholic) must be annulled or otherwise resolved through the proper Church process.
- Catholics must provide a newly issued baptismal certificate. Non-Catholics should provide a copy of their original baptismal record.
- Meet with the priest once or twice in preparation for the sacrament.
- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession).
- Exchange marriage vows in the Church.


